Discussions were held on all the agenda items. Following are the deliberations:

Item 1: Review of Vision & Mission statements of the department.

The vision and mission statements of the department were presented and no change was suggested.

Item 2: To review the scheme and syllabi of B.Tech (VI, VII & VIII Semester) & M.Tech. (I & Il semester)

- (i) Following subjects are recommended to be added to the list of elective subjects -
 - Elective V
 - Advanced Graph Theory
 - Introduction to Soft Computing . CO
 - Elective VI
 - Data Mining . CO
 - CO User Centric Computing for Human Computer Interaction
- (ii) After due discussion, it was recommended that after a student gets admitted in the Institute, he/she should be allowed to take and complete any Elective subject available

as MOOC course, in any semester (but not later than the semester in which the subject is present in the scheme).

(iii) A student should be allowed to choose any other elective subject in next semester if (a) he/she attended the classes in offline mode and got detained in the chosen elective

(b) the student failed in the subject in the exam conducted on the MOOCs platform. OR

(iv) The BoS recommended that the registration fee for the MOOCs courses must be paid by

(v) In light of modification of I B.Tech, scheme, it is observed that many topics of subject EC24010:Analog and Digital Electronics are being covered in syllabus of subject EC10508 Basic electronics (newly added in the scheme of 1st year B.Tech.). It was therefore recommended to replace the subject EC24010: Analog and Digital Electronics with a new subject EC______ Microprocessors and Microcontrollers in II B.Tech. (semester III). The Chairman, BoS Elx. & TC be requested for the needful.

Item 3: Discussion on recommendations of DPQAIC (meeting held on 09/12/22) on increased intake

(i) DPQAIC had pointed out that current available resources of the department may not be sufficient to cater to the requirements due to increased intake of 120 seats. Hence for effective teaching and learning, the class be divided into three sections of approximately 65 students each for teaching theory and into at least six batches for practical.

(ii) Since the number of students is very large for a teacher to manually evaluate the test copies of students, more number of online tests and quizzes be conducted, apart from

the conventional descriptive class tests.

Item 4: Any other Item (with the permission of Chair):

(i) As per the request of Chairman, BoS, Industrial and Production Engineering, the subject CO23559 Object Oriented Programming currently being offered in IV semester of B.Tech. (IPE) is recommended to be shifted to III semester of B.Tech. (IPE).

(ii) NEP Implementation in technical education was discussed and the members suggested that discussion on this may be deferred till a formal model is designed and proposed by

RGPV or AICTE.
