Shri G. S. Institute of Technology and Science, Indore was established in 1952, All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) and University Grant Commission (UGC), New Delhi, have declared the institute as autonomous in 1989. Under the autonomous state, the institute is affiliated to the Rajiv Gandhi Proudyogiki Vishwavidhyalaya (university of technology of M.P.) Bhopal.

Presently, the institute offers eleven UG courses (Regular) and twenty four PG courses with specializations in various disciplines under the emerging areas of Engineering, Technology, Applied Sciences, Computer Applications, Management & Pharmacy. The Institute also runs two UG courses and three PG courses for Working Professional approved by the AICTE, approved by the Rajiv Gandhi Proudyogiki Vishwavidhyalaya (university of technology of M.P.) Bhopal.

Shri G. S. Institute of Technology & Science, Indore is registered under Societies Registration Act 53, 1950 of Government of Madhya Pradesh and Affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi Proudyogiki Vishwavidyalaya, Bhopal. The college has a Governing Body which is approved by the authority appointed by Government of Madhya Pradesh. It runs as per rules and regulations made by the Government from time to time.

The Institute comes under Local Fund Audit which gives certificate and remark regarding maintenance of financial transactions. The Institute has different bodies to maintain all types of disciplines on the campus.

All the cells or committees of the institution are under statutory bodies and come under section 4(1) (b) of RTI Act 2005.
